systematic use of place names which is novel in a welsh context it also provides key resources for other researchers by geolocating pre 1700 place names from a previously published survey creating gis resources polygons and geolocated databases from the 1840s tithe map and schedules for parishes in its detailed case study areas and providing a geolocated database of 16th century demesne and welsh law landholdings in the cantref
